



## Catamaran

Mainly in Varadero, a day on catamaran is one of the most representative activities that let you appreciate the Caribbean atmosphere and particularly the most beautiful thing you can find in the perimeter of Cuba: the coral reef, the second most important in the world, after Australia. The navigation will be smooth and you will admire the nuances of the exceptional blues of the water that result from the variety of landscapes. You will pass among the small islets with pristine white sand and go swimming in the sea over a closed basin with a footbridge on piles where dauphins are living in semicaptivity. To be in the water with them, to touch them and see those cetaceans rubbing their muzzles against you are some of the unforgettable moments of this day. Then, you will have lunch in one of those Cayos (islets): special arrangements have made possible that a thatched hut stands on the beach. There you will taste the famous Cuban lobster. You will sail one hour and a half to return to the marina and finish your memorable excursion day

Sea excursion. Departure from Varadero: Crucero del Sol

On bus from the hotel to the Marina (at the end of Varadero). Day Charter style catamarans for 70 guests that belong to the Fontaine French company. Pajot Tahiti model. Open bar on board. National drinks. Departure: about 9 a.m. Return: 5 p.m .

- Flippers and snorkel (depth : 5 meters).
- Swim with dauphins : by group (10 persons aligned et static).
- Lunch in Cayo Blanco. Wooden hut. Beach. Open bar. Lobster in a sauce, white rice, shrimps and fish filet. Crudités, dessert and grilled lobster tail extra charge.
- Time at the beach after lunch, return to the marina (sailing if the wind is favorable). Transfer by bus to the hotel.

Private catamarans

- 2 to 10 participants: excursion on a motor boat. Same conditions
- 11 to 20 participants: two motor boats
- 40 persons and more: private use of the Tahiti.

It is difficult to obtain a private boat when the group is composed of 20 to 35 participants.
